- **Image #1 -** The Eagle (Hosea 8:1-6)
 - A. Message: Trouble will come
 - B. Warning: Sin isn't worth the trouble
- Image #2 Sowing and Reaping (Hosea 8:7)
 - A. Message: You reap what you sow
 - B. Warning: You will not like the harvest
- **Image #3 –** Cheap Pottery (Hosea 8:8)
 - A. Message: Sin seeks importance
 - B. Warning: Sin leads to devaluation
- **Image #4 Wild Donkey (Hosea 8:9a)**
 - A. Message: Sin finds company
 - B. Warning: Sin will ultimately leave you alone
- Image #5 Hired Lovers (Hosea 8:9b-10)
 - A. Message: Love is offered for sale
 - B. Warning: Sin's price is enormously high
- **Image #6 –** Egyptian Bondage (Hosea 8:11-9:9)
 - A. Message: It is easy to forget past lessons
 - B. Warning: Sin will cause repeated misery
- **Image #7 –** A Farm (Hosea 9:10-10:15)
 - A. Message: Sin seems promising
 - B. Warning: Sin never produces lasting results

Conclusion: Seek to have a far-sighted view of sin.
